

RESOLUTION NO. 2009-027

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REEDLEY TO LEVY AND COLLECT THE ANNUAL ASSESSMENTS FOR LANDSCAPING AND LIGHTING MAINTENANCE DISTRICT NO. 1 OF THE CITY OF REEDLEY AND SETTING DATE FOR HEARING

BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Reedley as follows:

1. It is the intent of said Council to order the levy and collection of assessment under the Landscaping and Lighting Act of 1972, part two of Division 15, of the Streets and Highways Code (beginning with Section 22500 of said code and herein the "act") of Landscaping and Lighting Maintenance District No. 1 of the City of Reedley for fiscal year 2009-2010; and

2. The territory of City Landscaping and Lighting Maintenance District No. 1 is comprised of various zones located throughout the City as shown on the attached map, Exhibit "A" which is the real property benefitted and to be assessed for the maintenance and operation of the landscaping and facilities of Landscaping and Lighting Maintenance District No. 1; and

3. The Engineer has prepared and filed with the City Clerk of the City of Reedley a report labeled Engineer's Report of the City of Reedley Landscaping and Lighting Maintenance District No. 1, dated June 2009, to which reference is hereby made by a description of the existing improvements, the boundaries of the assessment district and any zones therein (including the general location), and the proposed assessment upon assessable lots and parcels of land within Landscaping and Lighting Maintenance District No. 1; and

4. Notice is hereby given that on the **14th day of July, 2009, at the hour of 7:00 p.m.**, or soon thereafter, in the City Council Chambers, 845 G Street, Reedley, is hereby fixed as the time and place when all interested persons shall be heard on the question of the levy and collection of the proposed assessments. Written protests may be filed with the City Clerk at any time prior to the conclusion of the hearing. A written protest

shall state all grounds of objection and shall contain a description sufficient to identify the property owned by the protesting person or persons. Exhibits are on file in the office of the City Clerk.

5. A copy of this resolution shall also be published by the City Clerk once prior to the public hearing in a newspaper of general circulation within the City of Reedley, at least 10 days prior to the public hearing in accordance with applicable provisions of said Chapters of the Streets and Highways Codes of California.

6. The assessments charged to Zones A, B, D, E, F, G, and H are not proposed to increase from the previous years assessment. Zones I, J, K, L, N, O, P, R and U are proposed to a CPI increase from the previous 2008-2009 fiscal year assessment.



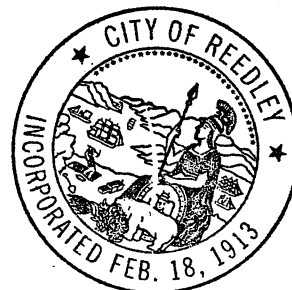


EXHIBIT A
